1. Grant Summary

To address new social issues caused by the new coronavirus, the Ritsumeikan SDGs P romotion Headquarters has launched the "Beyond COVID -19" online community to s upport the challenges of students.

At "Beyond COVID -19", in order to further grow as a platform to support young people who are taking on challenges, we will develop further activities to solve social issues in view of the society with COVID -19 and after COVID -19.

This grant invites students to participate in projects that challenge them to solve soci al problems, and grants are provided to cover the costs of these activities. We will als o use the Beyond COVID -19 platform to support the implementation of public relatio ns projects.

Resources of this grant is funded by the donation-based crowdfunding program Stud ents' Challenges Lead to a Future with/after COVID-19" (https://readyfor.jp/projects/ rits-beyond-covid19), which started on June 5, 2020 in cooperation with READYFOR Corporation, a RIMIX partner company.

[Characteristics of This Grant]

- We support students who belong to Ritsumeikan to open up the world post C OVID-19 and aim to realize the project.
- Among the SDGs, we will focus on social issues that have emerged through th e spread of the coronavirus infection and support students and student projec ts that solve these issues through business view.
- □ We will respond to the changing society due to the pandemic and provide su pport for students project by actively utilizing online. By adding the benefits of online solutions that go beyond distance, time, and cost constraints, we are ab le to meet the challenges of the real world more quickly and effectively.

B. Amount of grant

Approx. ¥300,000 per poject

*Grant amount will be decided by considering the application contents.

C. Method of Payment

For the receipt of the grant, the bank account is identified only for the purp ose of the project.

(2) Project Covered by This Grant

In addition to overcoming the coronavirus disasters, this grant is designed to encoura ge students to come up with ideas for solving social issues in the era of With COVID -19 and After COVID -19, focusing on the possibilities that have emerged and social i ssues that have emerged during this period.

Accordingly, projects that satisfy all four "Criteria for projects for this grant" can apply for this grant. We also expect the projects shown in "Key areas for this grant".

<Criteria for Projects for This Grant>

- A. Projects to commit social challenges in Key areas for this grant
- **B.** Projects that incorporate a business perspective into problem solving and are conscious of sustainability
- c. Projects that are willing to continue their activities after the grant has been completed
- **D.** Projects with a view to pioneering a with COVID-19/after COVID-19 society, s uch as using the online system

<Key Areas for This Grant>

When we think of a with COVID-19/after COVID-19 society, it is essential to look to ward society as a whole. Based on the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) set by the United Nations, this grant will focus on the following social issues that have e merged as a result of the spread of the new coronavirus infection.

- □ **#StayHome** (SDGs goal 3,11,12,etc.) new lifestyles, food and health needs, etc.
- #NextCarrer (SDGs goal 5,8,9,etc.)
 New platform of learning, potential ways of working, creative online content creation, etc.
- #GlobalNow (SDGs goal 4,10,17,etc.)
 New study abroad system, cross-cultural understanding, etc.

4. Application

(1) Who Can Apply

- A. For group applications: Of the members of the group, at least three and at least 2/3 are students who enrolled at Ritsumeikan as of June 1, 2020.
- B. For individual applications: Students who enrolled at the Ritsumeikan as of June 1, 2020.
- C. Multiple applications by the same person are not allowed. In addition, in the ca se of an group applications, the applicant may not apply concurrently as representation, vice representation, or accounting in plural projects.

5. Selection

(1) Selection Requirement

Project must meet all of the requirement which is specified in section 3. Details of th e grant (2) Project covered by this grant < Criteria for projects for this grant >"

(2) Scoring Points for Selection

The following 5 points will be judged by 4 members of the selection committee, and each member will evaluate the total of 25 points, 100 points in total, and decide the acceptance or rejection.

- A. Independent Project execution · Willingness to achieve the plan [5point]
- B. focus point · Social impact [5point]
- C. Uniqueness and creativity of the plan [5point]
- D. Marketability and Sustainability of the Plan [5point]
- E. Past Achievements [5point]

(3) Selection Method

- We will check the documents based on the selection requirement and decide who will be interviewed.
- We will decide the acceptance or rejection after the selection by online interv iew.

(4) Selection Committee

In addition to school faculty member, Ritsumeikan alumni participate as judges in th e selection process.

6. Obligations of the Grant Recipient

- Reporting and releasing of project results through reports, results reporting m eetings, websites, SNS, and media coverage
- Bank accounts for the grant
- Participation for financial literacy training and appropriate accounting. And rep orting of grants in line with the content of the training.
 *You need a voucher for the expenditure, such as a receipt after using the gra nt.% We recommend that you take the "President's Pitch Challenge" course t

o learn about building business models.

*Participation or non-participation does not affect the results of selection.

7. Rules for the use of grants

1. Usage

This grant may only be used to promote the project activity to be applied It cannot be used for entertainment, accommodation, or food or drink that is not rel ated to the promotion of project activities which it is granted.

2. Cancellation of Grant

The grant will be withdrawn if:.

- \cdot False statements or fraud at the time of application are found
- •A member of the group or individual who receive the grant is suspended or expelle d from school
- •The group or individual who receive the grant commits a crime or other illegal act
- ·The adopted project is suspended or postponed
- •The grant for purposes other than promoting the adopted project activity is used
- •Other cases where Ritsumeikan SDGs Promotion Headquarters finds it inappropriat e in light of the purpose of this grant.

3. Return and refund of grant

 \cdot If a grant is cancelled, you must return part or all of the grant within two weeks from the

date of cancellation.

• If f there is any balance in the grant as a result of checking the accounting report, re turn it to the Fund.
